## Indoor Athletics Festival

On 14th October, nearly 500 Y5/6 pupils from Burlish Park, Hagley, Stourport, The Knoll, Sutton Park, Birchen Coppice, Foley Park, Holy Trinity, St John's, Franche, Hartlebury, St Catherine's, Bewdley, Far Forest, St Anne's, Chaddesley Corbett and Bewdley Primary Schools attended the annual UII Indoor Athletics Festival. Leaders from Stourport High School led a mass warm up and supported the event, along with Wyre Forest District Council. During the Festival, pupils completed a range of track and field events, such as relay



and individual running races, vertical jump, speed bounce, standing long jump, standing triple jump and chest push.



Pupils scored points for their team no matter where they finished, which were added together over the course of the event.

St Catherine's won the event, with Burlish Park in 2nd and Sutton Park in 3rd. After the UII event, 250 pupils from King Charles, Stourport, Bewdley and Haybridge High Schools took part in the Y7 and Y8 competition using the same scoring system. Stourport won the Y7 girls competition, Bewdley won the Y8 girls competition, whilst Haybridge won both the Y7 boys and Y8 boys competitions. All of the winning teams will now represent the Wyre Forest at the Winter School Games in March.

## Football round up

Pupils from The Knoll, St John's, Sutton Park, Hagley, Stourport, Comberton, Cookley, Burlish Park, Hartlebury and Franche Primary Schools took part in an UII Girls Football competition at King Charles I Secondary School on 30th September. Refereed by King Charles students, teams played each other in two mini-leagues which were won by Hagley and Franche respectively. At full-time, the score was

0-0, so penalties decided the result, which Franche won 2-1. Hartlebury, Cookley, St Anne's, St John's, Offmore, Stourport, Bewdley, Holy Trinity, Comberton, The Knoll, Burlish Park, Hagley, Sutton Park, and Franche Primary Schools all took part in the Y5/6 Football League this half term. Over 160 pupils took part in the League, which ran over 4 consecutive weeks on Stourport High School's

astro-turf pitches. Like in the Girls competition, teams played in two mini-leagues, with a play-off in the final week to determine the overall winner. Congratulations to Hagley Primary School who beat Cookley 1-0 in the final.
