KS2/3 Leadership Day

On Friday 30th September, 75 KS3 students took part in a training day where they developed their leadership, planning and delivery skills. After receiving their training, the KS3 pupils delivered a carousel of activities to a small group of Y5/6 pupils. The 160 Y5/6 pupils then completed their Jumping Jaxx

Playleader training, before delivering an activity to Y2 pupils. The 15 Primary Schools who attended, now have a fully trained workforce to deliver activities at lunchtimes.



On 18th October, over 500 Y5/6 pupils from Hartlebury, Sutton Park, St John's, Franche, Stourport, Heronswood, Holy Trinity, Birchen Coppice, Far Forest, Hagley, Burlish Park, Foley Park, Clent, Bewdley, St Anne's Primary Schools attended the annual U11s Indoor Athletics Festival.



Leaders from Stourport High School led a mass warm up and supported the event, along

with Wyre Forest District Council. During the Festival, pupils completed a range of track and field events, such as relay and individual running races, speed bounce, vertical jump, standing long jump, standing triple jump and chest push.



Pupils scored points for their team no matter where they finished, which were added together over the course of the event.

Burlish Park won both the U11 girls and U11 boys events. After the U11 event, students from Baxter College, The Bewdley School, King Charles, Stourport and Haybridge High Schools took part in the Y7 and Y8 competition using the same scoring system. The Bewdley School won the Y8 girls competition and Haybridge won the Y7 girls, Y7 boys and Y8 boys competitions. All of the winning teams will now represent the Wyre Forest at the Winter School Games in March.

Football round up

123 girls from Sutton Park, Heronswood, Hartlebury, St John's, Comberton, Lickhill, Hagley, Far Forest, Burlish Park and Franche Primary Schools along with girls from King Charles, Stourport High and The Bewdley School took part in a Football Festival, at King Charles I School on 13th October, as part of Worcestershire's Girls Football Week.



Supported by Young Leaders from King Charles, the girls completed a range of drills which focused on passing, dribbling, tackling and shooting

before applying their skills in a series of mixed school games. Hartlebury, Cookley, Sutton Park, Stourport, Comberton, St Anne's, St John's, Offmore, Bewdley, Holy Trinity, Foley Park, The Knoll, Burlish Park, Hagley, Wilden, Chaddesley Corbett, Heronswood, Clent, Lickhill, Franche and Birchen Coppice, Primary Schools all took part in the Y5/6 Football League this half term. Over 200 pupils took part in the League, which ran over 4 consecutive weeks at Stourport High School. Congratulations to Hagley Primary School who finished up as overall winners.
