On 17th October, over 600 Y5/6 pupils from Holy Trinity, Cookley, Sutton Park, Hagley, St John's, Belbroughton, Foley Park, Stourport, Hartlebury, Burlish Park, Far Forest, Clent, Chaddesley Corbett, Franche, Bewdley Primary Schools took part in our annual U11 Indoor Athletics Festival.

Leaders from Stourport High School supported the event, along with Wyre Forest District Council.



During the Festival, pupils completed a range of track and field events, such as relay and individual running races, speed bounce, vertical jump, standing long jump, standing triple jump and chest push.



Pupils scored points for their team no matter where they finished, which were added together over the course of the event.

Burlish Park won both the

U11 girls and U11 boys events. After the U11 event, students from Baxter College, Bewdley, King Charles, Wolverley, Haybridge and Stourport High Schools took part in the Y7 and Y8 competition using the same scoring system.

The Bewdley School won the Y7 girls, Y8 girls and Y8 boys competitions and Stourport High School won the Y7 boys competition.

All of the winning teams will now represent the Wyre Forest at Worcestershire's Winter School Games taking place on February 12th.

Football round up



180 girls from Burlish Park, Hagley, Comberton, Franche, Stourport, Upper Arley, Far Forest, St John's, Sutton Park, Hartlebury and Clent Primary Schools along with girls from Baxter College, Bewdley and Haybridge High Schools took part in a Football Festival, at King Charles I School on 12th October.

Supported by Worcestershire FA and Wyre Forest's Sport Development Officer, Young Leaders from King Charles led a range of drills for the girls which focused on passing, dribbling, tackling and shooting before applying their skills in a series of mixed school games. Hartlebury, Stourport, Foley Park, Comberton, St Anne's,

St John's, St Bartholomew's, Bewdley, Holy Trinity, Burlish Park, Hagley, Heronswood, Lickhill, Franche and Birchen Coppice, Primary Schools also took part in the Y5/6 Football League this half term. Over 160 pupils took part in the League, which ran over 4 consecutive weeks. Congratulations to Hagley Primary School who finished up as overall winners, beating Birchen Coppice in a tense final which went to extra time and then penalties!
