KS2 pupils from Far Forest, Bewdley, Burlish Park, St Anne's, Stourport, Lickhill, Cookley, Heathfield, Foley Park, Birchen Coppice, St John's and St Kenelm's competed in 5 mini-leagues whilst KS3 students from The

Bewdley School, Stourport High, Wyre Forest School, King Charles and Baxter College competed in 2 mini-leagues, all supported by 24 Young Leaders from Stourport and Bewdley.



St Kenelm's won the KS2 New Age Kurling event with Stourport High School

winning the KS3 event.



Burlish Park won the KS2 Boccia with Stourport finishing as runners-up. King Charles won the KS3 event, with Baxter College finishing second.

All of these schools will now progress to the Worcestershire School Games.
