Athletics Festivals

KS3 students from King Charles, Baxter College, The Bewdley School, Haybridge and Stourport High Schools competed in a Super 6 Athletics event on Friday 5th May.

Two competitions took place - one combined for Y7/8 students and one for Y9 students. Both competitions were supported by Young Leaders from Stourport High. All students competing, had to take part in one track (sprint, middle and long distance), one field (javelin, long jump, shot)

and one relay (4x100m, mixed medley) event, scoring points for their team. Stourport High School won both of the competitions and will now progress to Worcestershire's Summer School Games as the Wyre Forest representatives.

Following the Super 6, KS2 pupils from Hagley, Franche, WFS, Holy Trinity, St Anne's, Burlish Park, Bewdley, St George's and St Kenelm's Primary Schools all took part in an Athletic Activities

Festival which targeted pupils who hadn't represented their school before.

Pupils were split into mixed school groups and rotated round a range of running (80m sprint, 400m, hurdles), jumping (long jump) and throwing (hammer, javelin) activities.

All pupils were encouraged to achieve their 'Personal Best' with certificates being presented to the girl and boy who achieved the best time/

Year 3/4 and Year 5/6 Tennis

On Tuesday 16th May, 80 Y3/4 and Y5/6 pupils from Burlish Park, Cookley, Hartlebury, Holy Trinity, Heathfield Knoll, St John's, Hagley, Franche and Sutton Park Primary Schools took part in the SSP's Tennis Festival, held at Bewdley Tennis Club.

The event was supported by Bewdley's Head Coach, Geoff Barrie and 20 Young

Leaders from The Bewdley School, Stourport and Haybridge High Schools. Teams played in 2 mini-leagues, with the winners of each league playing-off to determine an overall winner. All of the pupils involved in the Festival were non-rated players, meaning they don't currently play competitive Tennis for a club. Playing mini-Tennis Red, the

Y3/4 team from Franche and the Y5/6 team from Hagley both won their respective competitions.

The pupils from these teams will now represent the Wyre Forest at the Summer School Games, competing against teams from the other Worcestershire's District.

Year 3/4 Tri-Golf Festivals

Y3/4 pupils from across the Wyre Forest took part in Family Tri-Golf Festivals on Friday 28th April.

Prior to the Festivals, students from King Charles, Bewdley, Wolverley and Stourport High Schools received training that enabled them to support the Festival, scoring the activities

and offering coaching to the teams, which were made up of 5 boys and 5 girls. Pupils rotated round 8 activity stations, scoring points for their team. After all the Festivals had taken place, the team from Burlish Park had scored the most points.
